


The Joint ITE International and Midwestern/Great Lakes Districts Annual Meeting and Exhibit in August was attended in Minneapolis by Deep South Members **Hibbett Neel**, **Alison Michel**, **Daniel Helms**, **Akhil Chauhan**, and **Josh Harrouch** along with many others from the Southern District and ABD. In the days before the meeting, Daniel Helms completed his Leadership ITE classes and was recognized at the graduation ceremony in conjunction with the ITE and MWITE/GLITE Excellence in Transportation Awards. At the meeting was the election of three new Honorary Members – John J. Kennedy, Marsha Anderson Bomar and our own **W. Hibbett Neel**. This is the highest recognition of notable and outstanding professional achievement presented by ITE, and Deep South's last Honorary Member was John Exnicios who was elected in 2002.

In addition to an outstanding technical program with speakers from all over the world, the City of Minneapolis offered many opportunities to observe and participate in various modes of transportation. 

Honda's smart intersection tells drivers what's around the corner

Honda has created and is testing a smart intersection in Marysville, OH. Wide angle cameras are mounted above the traffic lights at the intersection of Fifth and Main. These cameras monitor the intersection and notify drivers of pedestrians, emergency vehicles, and other cars that are not yet visible to entering drivers. Honda has equipped 20 Honda Pilots with specially built HUD (heads up display) technology to alert drivers of potential issues before reaching the intersection. Full Article here.



LSU engineer hopes invention will make construction faster, cheaper and safer as it heads to test phase

LSU Engineering professor Guoqiang Li is working to develop a polymer-based sealant to use in road construction and repair. While most materials expand when heated and contract when cooled, Ll's material behaves in the opposite way, forming a tighter seal than silicon. Li will first focus on using the substance to seal joints where concrete pavement slabs meet, and will then look into crack repair applications. Full article here.


